

Sharing Best Practices Work Stream

Process for submitting, reviewing and posting material on the Ethics website

Members' Area

Background:

This work stream aims to build a databank of documents and initiatives in different formats, including materials that are ready to share (such as brochures, videos, case studies), including links to other websites to access their materials and ideas (such as e-learning on National Associations' websites, and links to educational materials about ethics and compliance on law firm or consultants websites). We will post these onto our website for all members to use.

All members are **strongly encouraged to share best practices** and initiatives that work well, have no intellectual property or confidentiality issues, and are not commercially sensitive from a competition law perspective.

Submission ground rules:

- 1. Please write a short summary a short content summary, including key words for the search functionality (e.g. "transparency", "training", "healthcare professionals") for each item submitted (or for a group of materials if they cover the same topic),
- 2. Add a disclaimer to each item submitted to confirm the material has been properly cleared in your organization for submission:
 - "The materials submitted do not contain any information which is commercially sensitive from a competitive perspective, IP-protected, confidential or proprietary to this company. They are suitable for sharing among the members of ETHICS and have been cleared for this purpose in line with the applicable internal company or organization policy".

Process:

- Send your materials by email to "contact@ethicspros.com", including content summary, keywords, the disclaimer above, and if you agree your name is displayed as a contact for any question related to this material:
- 2. Content review by the Work Stream team members, within 60 days from submission date;
- 3. Feedback to submitter with our thanks [accepted or rejected (with reasons)];
- The Work Stream team members upload the selected material to the ETHICS website Members' Space;
- 5. All members get an email notification that the material has been uploaded;
- 6. New materials gets a NEW flash for 60 days from initial upload;
- 12 months after posting, the submitter will receive an email asking them to let the Work Stream know whether the material is still relevant, or should be revised or archived.
