Topics covered by the Code - Outline

Introduction from Dominique and Roeland

1. Members participate actively and contribute effectively to ETHICS, with integrity and in the interest of the profession's reputation
2. All interactions must preserve confidentiality and be in compliance with competition law
3. Members must have knowledge, skills and capabilities and strive for continuous learning
4. Link to Competency Model
5. Members act in their individual professional capacity and not in representation of companies
6. Members network, share experiences and practices
7. Members use ETHICS as a sounding board and respect diversity of views
8. Members avoid or address conflicts of interest
9. Members' relations with other professionals must be guided by mutual respect
10. Members' professional and personal conduct must not bring discredit to the profession/industry
11. Violations to the Code to be reported to the Board
